## A DURABLE PEACE THROUGH DEMOCRATIC RESILIENCE: THE NORDIC–UKRAINE PARTNERSHIP AT SCALE

The Nordic Ukraine Advocacy Summit (NUAS) 2026 is an independent, high-level forum that brings together Nordic and Ukrainian civil society organisations, the Ukrainian diaspora, decision-makers, and leading public voices to strengthen coordinated support for Ukraine and Nordic security. Now in its fourth edition, NUAS reflects growing regional demand for a structured, long-term Nordic–Ukraine partnership.

The Summit's Panel Discussion Day will take place on Monday, 11 May, at the Folketinget as a high-level forum focused on coordination, knowledge exchange, and long-term impact. It features three moderated panel discussions addressing key dimensions of regional cooperation and resilience
